

Helping Hands

What is it?

Armed with a selection of paints, your guests will be asked to create an individual handprint on which they can state their five aims and objectives for the year ahead. Unbeknown to them the individual pieces that seemingly stand alone all come together to form their event logo in a dramatic unveiling.

How does it work?

There are various ways the detail of the event can be changed but the basic format is that the participants each paint their handprints on an A4 sheet of card. Each of the handprints is in a previously specified colour, which will eventually create the company logo or picture that has been specified. Whilst the handprints are drying the teams may wish to discuss their contribution to the company, and their aims. Once the hand paintings are dry, they can cut them out and write their five objectives on each thumb and finger (and their name on the back of the hand!).

At the end of the event it is revealed that the handprints all fit together to create this final picture, and they are assembled for due admiration. A photo will be taken of this final image, and the handprints given back to the individuals to keep.
